


Revenue 2022-2023

Truly, I appreciate that the PTD Enrichment Fund allowed me to explore a second language. I am continuing to work on my skills and will be visiting my son, daughter-in-law, and grandsons soon so I will even be practicing with other Spanish speakers! Estoy tan emocionada!"
